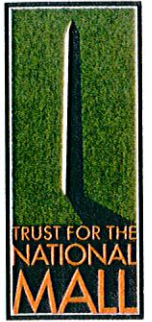


Dear Mr. Jasser,




